**Previous Meeting Minutes:** <u>Keith Henry</u> made motion to accept the previous month's minutes as presented. Seconded by *Renae Stanford*. Motion carried.

*Financial Report:* <u>Megan Malmay</u> reviewed the March P&L; hotel revenue was \$9,904.02; the balance sheet total for checking/savings as of March 31<sup>st</sup> was \$461,383.41. Accounts receivable showed (\$26,220.53) this amount is from the Revival Fund that needs to be spent this year. There's an additional \$50k in deferred reveanue to be spent in the next two years from the revival fund. Total current assets were \$487,994.34. <u>Renae Stanford</u> made a motion to accept the financials as presented. Second by <u>Nora Benoit</u>. Motion carried.

Vice Chairwoman: <u>Suzette Leonards</u> stated our next board meeting will be on May 11<sup>th</sup> at 9am.

**Directors Report**: Nancy Loewer sent in advance and asked if there were any comments and none were provided. <u>Suzette Leonards</u> offered to the board if anyone wanted to ride on a float for the Frog Festival that they needed to let Nancy know by Wednesday, April 19<sup>th</sup>.

**Old Business**: <u>Josh Spell</u> made a motion to accept the proposel for the permanent sign for \$13,325. Second by <u>Michele Veillon</u>. Motion carried.

**New Business**: The collecting of EDD tax has been tabled for further research. <u>Renae Stanford</u> made a motion to accept Jamie Tony's landscaping estimate for \$963 and to round it up to \$1,000. Second by <u>Megan Malmay</u>. Motion carried. Discussing hiring a Summer Intern and what to pay, it came to the attention of Josh Spell that Amy Mathiew the Administrative Coordinator was making around \$12 an hour and he felt she isn't making enough. <u>Josh Spell</u> made the motion to increase the hourly pay to \$15 an hour for Amy Mathiew the Administrative Coordinator and having it retro back to April 1, 2023. Seconded by *Renae Stanford*. Motion carried. <u>Renae Stanford</u> made a motion to start the Summer Intern at \$11 an

hour and on performance have the pay increased to \$13 an hour. Second by <u>Michele Veillon</u>. Motion carried. Adjustments will be made to the budget to reflect landscaping and pay increase for payroll. Nancy Loewer stated we need an attorney that is familiar in tourism. Nancy will inquire who the commission should hire. <u>Keith Henry</u> made a motion to change the definition of "overnight camping facilities". Second by *Nora Benoit*. Motion carried.

**Committees Reports**: <u>Harold Fonte</u> stated we need to send another email explaining we need a local receipe to put in advertisement and it's needed by May 31, 2023. <u>Bart Wild</u> reported that the Long Range Planning committee had a good meeting with the Hoffpauirs concerning a land swap for equal value and we agreed to pay half of both land apprasals. No discussion on taxation committee due to Luke Dupre' not being present at the board meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
