**Call to Order**: Suzette Leonards

Called the meeting to order with roll call, noting there is a quorum.

**Welcome/Approval/Oath:** <u>Marietta Leonards</u> made a motion to approve Nicole DeJean-Broussard as our new commissioner, representing Acadia Parish Chamber of Commerce/at Large "C".

<u>Harold Fonte</u> second the motion. Motion carried. Honorable Luke Beslin administered the oath of office @ 9:05 AM and Nicole was added to the quorum.

# **Previous Meeting Minutes:**

<u>Keith Henry</u> made a motion to accept June 12, 2025, minutes as presented. Second by <u>Chelsey Gallow Hopkins</u>. Motion carried.

#### Legislative Auditor: John Istre & Corey J. Hulin – Broussard Poche, LLC

Mr. John prepared a summarized report to make it quicker and easier for everybody to understand. He stated total assets for 2024 were \$1,134,081. "In 2023, it was \$1,193,331. You had a drop of \$59,250. Total cash at the end of 2024 was \$245,554. At the end of 2023, it was \$344,599. You had a drop of \$99,045. The primary reason is in 2023 you had an advance on the grant and that money was sitting in your checking account. In 2024 you spent the rest of the Revival Fund, or you would lose the money not spent at the end of 2024. Taxes are receivable, this is hotel motel tax, 2024 ended with \$42,390. At the end of 2023 it was \$17,800. You had an increase of \$24,590. Investments at the end of 2024 were \$117,127. At the end of 2023 it was \$149,963. You moved \$40,000 to money market (CD's) account. Total current liabilities - accounts payable/\$2,337, accrued expenses/\$666, at the end of 2024.

Total net position or equity in 2024 was \$1,127,380 versus 2023 was \$1,064,591, which was up \$62,789." He spoke to the commission regarding accounting changes and accounting standards which all governmental entities are required to adopt. We are also working on past audit issues in QuickBooks and addressing those right now. We had to get through this audit first. Nicole is helping Wendy with QuickBooks, and we are going to get it corrected.

## **Director's Report/New Business:** Wendy

She introduces Chere, our new communication specialist. Chere is taking care of our Facebook and three other social media outlets we have. As well as helping me with grant research, writing and funding. We will be attending a grant writing class next week. The Lieutenant Governor's office provided this course to us, and we are excited about this opportunity. Building our community event center is on the list, but having a place to house the rice museum equipment is a must.
